Italy, NV

Pale lemon colour, with creamy bubbles. This organic offering has a delicate and complex bouquet with fruity notes of peach, green apple and lemon interlaced with floral hints of acacia and rose. 11% vol (1)

Central Valley, Chile, 2021/22

On the nose, tropical fruit aromas whilst on the palate, citrus fruits, a light body and a balanced acidity. 121/2% vol (2)

Marlborough, New Zealand, 2020/21

Intense gooseberry aromas alongside fresh herbaceous and grassy notes. Vibrant passion fruit, citrus and peach characters with top notes of melon and kiwi balanced with softer apple and white pear flavours. Well structured zesty acidity with fantastic length and elegance. 13½% vol (1)

Puglia, Italy, 2020/21

A full-bodied soft wine giving characteristic notes of ripe plum and raisins. Oak ageing adds to the intensity with pleasing notes of spice and vanilla. 13½% vol (D)

37 Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva Estate Collection, Viu Manent - Vegan Colchagua Valley, Chile, 2020/21

40 Côtes du Rhône Rouge, Colombo & Fille

Côtes du Rhône, Rhône, France, 2019/20

A bright and seductively fruity wine packed with red fruit characters, well-rounded tannins and balanced acidity. 13½% vo (C)

41 Carménère, Secret, Viu Manent - Vegan

Colchagua Valley, Chile, 2020/21

This intense violet-coloured wine stands out for the Carménère's typical spicy character with aromas of black pepper as well as red fruits, berries, and a subtle note of fresh-ground coffee. The medium-bodied palate presents good volume, balance, and a smooth texture that leads to a very pleasing finish. 14% vol (C)

42 Cave des Grands Vins de Fleurie

Beaujolais, Burgundy, France, 2020/21

This wine, arrayed in a deep garnet hue flecked with purple, offers up a powerful black fruit bouquet. Notes of slightly tart blackberries give this wine a nice balance. On the palate, the powerful, smooth tannins reinforce the succulent character of this Fleurie, which delivers a lovely, long-lingering finish. 13% vol (B)

McLaren Vale, Australia 2021/22

Landlord's Choice - vibrant and fresh unoaked Shiraz. Aromas of plum and red berry on the nose and palate. All natural, biodynamic, organic and no added preservatives. Great with any type of meat. 14% vol (B)

44 Pinot Noir, The Crossings

Marlborough, New Zealand, 2020/21

Finely poised aromas of red cherry, spice, raspberry and gentle smokiness. The palate is vibrantly intense with a full, rich and silky mouthful. 13½% vol (B)

Rioja, Spain, 2016/17

WINE TRIVIA

- A "cork tease" is someone who always talks about opening a bottle of wine, but never does!
- Early Roman women were not allowed to drink wine. Any husband who
 found his wife consuming alcohol was free to kill her. Divorce on these
 grounds was last recorded in Rome in 194 B.C.
- Did you know that there are people who are afraid of wine? They are called Oenophobics.
- There really is a proper way to hold your wine glass! Always hold a glass by its stem. This will avoid your body heat raising the temperature of your wine, and eliminating the possibility of ruining that lovely liquid!

47 Muscat de St Jean de Minervois, Domaine Les Tailhades

South of France, 2012/13

Expressive sweet wine, with dried apricot, exotic fruit, rose flower and orange peel aromas. Rich in the mouth with honey and citrus fruit notes on the finish. 15% vol (5)

48 Botrytis Semillon, Deen Vat 5 De Bortoli - Vegetarian

Riverina, New South Wales, Australia, 2017/18

De Bortoli Vat 5 is a perfect expression of botrytis: pure luminescent gold in colour, with intense marmalade and dried peel fruit flavours, plus the botrytis honeyed effect. 10½% vol (5)
